





Message from the Principal

West Hills Middle School Loves Trust Land Funds.

I wanted to take the time to let everyone know how our school has benefited from the School Trust Land funds. At West Hills Middle School, we use these funds to provide the following supports for student learning.

- · We provide after school tutoring with a licensed teacher each Tuesday and Thursday in Mathematics, Language Arts, Science, Social Studies and Study Skills. This program is structured to support students struggling with concepts or attendance issues, giving them extra time to make-up missing work and get remediation.
- · Students involved in the English as a Second Language (ESL) language acquisition class benefit from a 17 hr. aide who monitors grades and reading score progress, assists the teacher in one-on-one tutoring and lesson and test preparation, assists students in difficult classes, and visits teachers requesting accommodations for ESL students. With the highly skilled aide, we are working towards closing the achievement gap for our ESL students.
- Money is used for mobile computer lab upgrades, audio and computer equipment and software.
- · We are dedicated to continuing implementation of middle level philosophy complete with integrated curriculum, developmentally responsive instruction, and collaboration between staff members. Funds are used for inschool mentor training with substitutes to cover, team curriculum planning, registration fees for local middle level education conferences with substitutes, and professional development in content specific areas. Progress will be assessed through surveys, test results, and long-term impact on student achievement.

I sincerely thank our School Community Council members for their support and help in writing the School Land Trust proposal each year. We would also like to thank the Utah Legislators for their continued support for the School Land Trust Fund; we see tremendous benefits.


