  - Reading Plus we have 83% of our students who use the Reading Plus Program (in the reading classes), have gone up 1-4 grade levels. Reading Plus works on comprehension and fluency reading skills. It is accessible to all West Hills students and their siblings.   - Band had zero proficiency on their pre-test and ended up with 100% proficiency with their post test.
  - 187 of our 9th graders passed the MOS test. We are so proud!

## REMODEL:

## OPEN DISCUSSION:

- What is SBG? -
  - Measuring a students' success on the target goals they are working on.
  - Student is aware of a goal. He is aware of how to reach that goal (Proficiency Scales), and he is given feedback through the process as he

reaches this goal.

- Grades are given a different point system than an A-F (although transferred into that format for report cards.) The grades are based on proficiency level of the standard (target). 1-4 scoring.
- Teachers are trained to look at the entirety of the process and not just plug in numbers.
