
Inventions of the World: What Crazy Things Have or Will be Invented?

How to be a Great Babysitter

Being a babysitter is fun but takes a lot of responsibility and patience. Some parents are very picky when it comes to picking a babysitter because they want to know their child is in good hands. How can you be a great babysitter, keep the child safe, and still have fun?

The biggest responsibility as a babysitter is to keep the child (children) you're watching safe. That means being ready for any situation that could danger the child. The topmost incidents that happen while babysitting are scrapes, cuts, bruises, burns, falls, poisoning, and choking. Make sure you have parent phone numbers to call in case an event like this takes place. It is also good to have another family member's number in case parents aren't answering in an emergency. And make sure you have any crisis number that you may need to call.

Some things you may want to consider to keep the kid(s) safe is by getting from the parents before they leave are a list of the child's allergies (food, seasonal, pet, and other types) and what you need to do if the child has an allergic reaction. Also, make sure you pay attention to types of toys and foods that the child could choke on. Being responsible, watching the child

closely, having fun is always important when you are babysitting.

Make sure to ALWAYS keep an eye on the kids because you do not know what they can get into so keep away all sharp, hot, and small objects such as knives, glass, blenders, ovens, stoves and very small toys all of this can cause choking, burns and cuts. If the parents let you take the kids swimming either at a public pool or a pool in the backyard. If you take a small child to swim, give it a floaty that fits snug on the body, give kids ages 1-6 (you do not want them to drown).

Also, do not let the kids climb tall places that are not safe that can cause bad injuries you do not want to get paid less. If a child is choking you must give the Heimlich simply wrap your arms around the chest, and lay your hand into a fist with one hand and in the other grab your fist and do about six to ten abdominal thrusts. But you do not just want babysitting to be about safety kids need some fun! Like, make a book with the kids to show their parents! If you are babysitting more than one kid do a race who can clean up the fastest?!

When you are babysitting you need to make sure that you are taking into consideration what the kid wants to do, if you can't, then offer an alternative that is similar to the thing they want to do. A way to find a similar thing to what they want to do is by thinking about why they want to do that one thing, and by thinking about what else the kid might want to, you can do that by asking them what they like to do. Most people babysit for the same reason that it is for money and because people love kids. It is found that the best way to get a baby to stop crying is by holding them while you are standing and swaying them from side to side.

Watching little girls? Play baby dolls with them or Barbies you always need to keep the kids entertained. Go outside and have even more races, do a talent show, make homemade ICE CREAM! You could also do a scavenger hunt. Go on a picnic, do arts and crafts

<u>A New Brain Chip</u> <u>for Humans</u>

Have you ever heard of chipping your dog or cat? Well what if you could chip a human? If you didn't know Elon Musk and his company Neuralink, is planting brain chips with an Al in it to help people control artificial limbs with their

thoughts. Neuralink was first introduced to the public at an event in June 2019 when Elon Musk unveiled his next big idea. He is planning to finish it by the end of 2020.

The new big idea that he is planning on are AI brain chips. He is the owner of Tesla and SpaceX. Neuralink (the company Elon Musk made for the brain chips) is implanting a wireless chip into a human brain by drilling a small hole in the skull and inserting thin, flexible threads of electrodes through brain tissue.

It would be interesting to see how a person with a disability would think of this chip, so with an interview with Aaron Clegg his disability is called radial dysplasia. Radial dysplasia is when your arm bends permanently and then makes your forearm shorter. We asked about his thoughts on chips



and would he get it. He said "Humans might be able to use chips to control electronics but can other humans use those chips to hack into peoples' brains", but if everything was worked out and chips really worked he would be willing to get one. He said that there was already a lot of information thrown at us so if people get chips we could stuff off the internet and have access to it. Then he said access on the internet "would keep my brain up at night thinking about what it all means. But he said that "I don't see brain chips being an option for many years to come, if ever."

Elon Musk has started this project for a bit now, but his first test was on a pig. The implant on the pig was a prototype to see how it would really work. Elon Musk hopes the implant can be used to help with the brain & spine problems in people. He also wants the entire process to be done by a robot. Elon musk said, ``breakthrough device' destination from the FDA in july. The idea is that these nmjc signals could be used to one day do things such as restore movement to people who are paralyzed or create a visual prosthesis for blindness.

With an interview with Mrs. Blake, a teacher at West Hills Middle School and asked her opinion on Elon Musk's chips. She said if you are paralyzed from head down it would be helpful to them so they could access electronics and it would help them in school and get stuff done. She said she

wouldn't get chipped because, not enough data right now for the idea if I was parallelized then maybe. Letting technology have that much power in the brain and when you depend on it, it could get hijacked and people could take advantage of that and do bad things with your body.

There is an advantage to this idea If you were chipped and got kidnapped and your parent(s) or anyone that legally owns you they could just track you and prove that you belong to them.

There is also a disadvantage to this. Just like what Mrs. Blake said, "when you depend on technology it could get hijacked. With all that technology in your brain it could get hacked easily (doesn't mean it will) and that is not safe nor healthy.

Tanner is an 8th grade Middle school student. He said he would get a chip if he really needed to like he said, "only if I was disabled".

Should the police be defunded?

It has been 4 months since the killing of George Floyd. Since that happened, many riots and protests have taken place. Black Lives Matter (BLM), an organization behind many of the protests, has promoted the idea of defunding the police. Some people agree, some are undecided, and others heavily disagree with BLM for their standing on the police. Why do these different groups of people believe the way they do?

What does defunding the police mean?

Defunding the police means taking money from them or reducing the amount of money that is going to the police. Defunding could also mean to completely get rid of them.



What do people think of defunding the police?

In an interview with police officer Tanner Nelsen, he said, "If the state government was to take away money from the police, people would not be able to get the help they need. Many people, when they don't know what to do in an emergency. They immediately think to call the police, and if there are no police to help them, they can be seriously harmed or injured."

He also mentioned that defunding the police would be nothing to stop people from committing crimes. That crime would increase and a lot more people would get hurt or even killed.

In Austin Texas, the crime rate has gone up since the protests on police defunding have started. There has been a 64% increase in the crime rate since 2019 and it keeps increasing. Austin Texas crime rate increase according to KVUE

Those who are in favor of defunding the police say that cutting the number of police officers and limiting the types of calls they respond to will reduce deaths related to discrimination by police

BLM, states on their website that "Police don't keep us safe — and as long as we continue to pump money into our corrupt criminal justice system at the expense of housing, health, and education investments — we will never be truly safe." They think

that the money the government spends on policing should be spent in other ways.

The most likely thing to happen would be that the crime rate would go up. Deaths from police would also go down. People wouldn't have a reason not to commit crimes. Less people will get killed from the police based on what race they are.

As of right now, In Utah, it looks like the police and their funding are going to stay. While there have been protests for defunding the police, there have been counter-protests that were to support the police. Both sides are still pushing their points. Some people are still trying to get




